

# Van Buren Cool Tools Behavioral Lesson Plan For Dismissal

**Universal Expectation:** Respect for Self, Others, and Property

**Name of the Skill/Setting:** Respect at dismissal

**Purpose of the lesson/Why it's important:**

- Students need the skills to know how to conduct themselves at the time of their dismissal.

**Teaching Examples:**

1. Presenter lets students know the need for each student to know and follow their own (family) after-school plan.
2. Explain that students should walk to their locker/cubby, continuing to follow school rules as they get ready to leave the building. If possible, walk the students from their classroom to the locker/cubby area.
3. Demonstrate packing up a backpack neatly; emphasize keeping hands, feet and personal property in own space. Explain how this is respecting others, property.
4. Demonstrate cleaning up their space, closing locker doors gently with hands (if applicable) and leaving the building in a timely manner.
5. Ask students to demonstrate a safe way to open the building doors. Use hands.

**Kid Activities/Role-Plays:**

- If you have time, students can role play the above procedure.

**Follow -Up/ Reinforcement**

- Classroom teachers should review the above procedures once per quarter with their class. Classroom teachers may have to help formulate after-school plans with individual students/families/other staff.
